The only activity during the timeframe that had the potential for CCR fugitive dust is the on-going ash pond closure project, which was completed in August 2025. This potential was mitigated by multiple water suppression trucks to wet the roads and construction areas in the immediate vicinity of the on-site CCR surface impoundment. Speed limits were posted to reduce vehicle speeds on all roads. Fugitive emissions at Plant Smith are also regulated under the facility's Title V Air Permit.
