

## Coal Combustion Residuals (CCR) Annual Fugitive Dust Control Report

**PLANT NAME:** Plant Crist

**OWNER/OPERATOR OF FACILITY:** Gulf Power

**REPORTING TIMEFRAME:** October 19, 2019 to October 19, 2020

**PURPOSE:** The purpose of this report is to demonstrate compliance with the requirements for the annual CCR fugitive dust control report set forth in 40 CFR § 257.80 (c). This report describes the actions taken by Plant Crist to control CCR fugitive dust, a record of all citizen complaints and if any, a summary of corrective measures taken.

### **DESCRIBE THE ACTIONS TAKEN TO CONTROL FUGITIVE DUST.**

A water suppression truck was used to wet the roads in the immediate vicinity of the on-site CCR landfills and surface impoundment and were also used when reclaiming CCR for beneficial reuse, as needed. The transfer of CCR from the silos into trucks for transportation occurred within a water curtain loading area. For on-site landfilling, water was added to the CCR prior to placement in the landfill cell, as needed. When CCR was transported off-site, enclosed tankers and/or covered trucks were used and they exited the loading area through a truck wash. Fugitive emissions at Plant Crist are also regulated under the facility's Title V Air Permit.

A water suppression truck was used on the roads at the site, as needed. Trucks carrying CCR were covered or enclosed. Water spray curtains were used at the silo loading area. Speed limits were posted to reduce vehicle speeds on all roads. Water suppression nozzles and wind curtains were used at the gypsum barn, as needed.
