Don't become a victim.

In one of the most common scams, a person may



Pretend to be from Florida Power & Light Company (FPL). Your caller ID may even display FPL's name.

Threaten to turn off power to your home or business within a few hours.





Demand immediate

payment only with cash, a prepaid card or wire transfer.

Suspect a scammer?

Here's what to do if the person seems suspicious:

(1) Hang up the phone.

2 Call the police.



DO NOT pay in person or over the phone if immediate payment is demanded to avoid disconnection.
